<b>Supporting Media Elements</b>	Media elements provide strong support for the point of view; interview is set up well with clear sound. Interview is not well set up and it's hard to hear voices.	No supporting media elements are used. Interview is not present or not clear.	
<b>Facts</b>	Uses and cites supporting facts from reliable sources	Uses supporting facts without citation; only one or two sources	Facts don't support point of view	Uses opinion without facts	
<b>Structure</b>	Narrative has a clear organizing structure and flows logically	Narrative has an organizing structure but needs some improvement	Narrative is disorganized	No attempt at an organizing structure is in place	
<b>Variety and Pacing</b>	Changes the screen image and/or audio on a regular basis to engage the audience	Changes media sometimes to engage audience, but pacing could be improved	Uses more than one medium, but doesn't engage audience	Uses only one medium	
<b>Production Values</b>	Has high-quality sound, video editing, camera work, and transitions	Production values could be better, but main idea is supported	Technical problems make the topic hard to understand	Technical problems ruin the video; the point is lost
